# 1. Devoted to One Another in Your Thinking

Romans 12:2-3 says: Do not be conformed to this world,  $[\underline{a}]$  but be transformed by the renewal of your <u>mind</u>, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect. For by the grace given to me I say to everyone among you not to <u>think</u> of himself more highly than he ought to <u>think</u>, but to <u>think</u> with sober judgment, each according to the measure of faith that God has assigned.

Philippians 2:2-5 "complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind. <sup>3</sup> Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. <sup>4</sup> Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. <sup>5</sup> Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus

Mark 10:43b-45 – But whoever would be great among you must be your servant, [a] **44** and whoever would be first among you must be slave[b] of all. **45** For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

John 13:13-15 – You call me Teacher and Lord, and you are right, for so I am. **14** If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. **15** For I have given you an example, that you also should do just as I have done to you.
